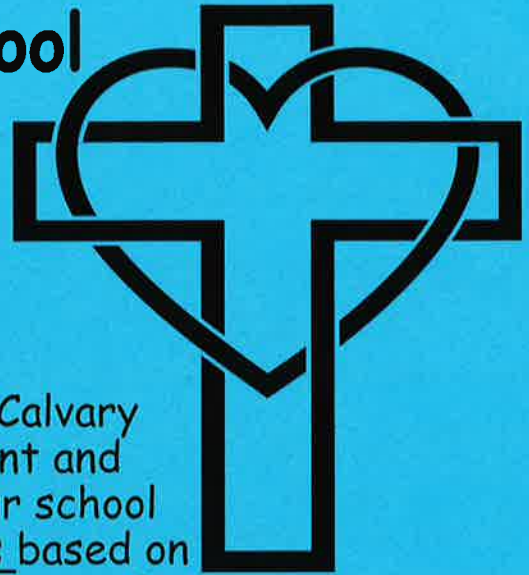


# Mt. Calvary Lutheran School Newsletter August 29, 2019



## GREETINGS FAMILIES

Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year at Mt. Calvary Lutheran School. Thank you for your commitment and dedication to learning and growing in Christ. ## DAILY ATTENDANCE

## STUDENT DROP OFF & PICK UP

To ensure safety for all students, please follow the morning drop off and pick up procedures. Students should be dropped off one way, with traffic moving north bound. It is much safer dropping students off on the same side as the school entry. Thanks for following this process to keep our students safe.

### **Extended Care Registration & Payments**

Do you anticipate that your child will need to go to Extended Care at any point during the year? If so, it is important to complete the registration form and submit the \$20 per child registration fee. Following the registration, the rate is \$4 per hour. Extended Care forms can be gotten from Mrs. Weber or the school office.

**Note:** Any Extended Care balances that remain from last year are now more than 60 days past due. As a result, students will be unable to participate in extracurricular activities and sports until the past due balance is paid in full.
